TRANSMITTAL OF ADOPTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CITY OF LOS ANGELES – TERMINAL ISLAND WATER RECLAMATION PLANT, SAN PEDRO, CA (NPDES NUMBER CA0053857, CI NUMBER 2171)
