**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS - AZUSA LAND RECLAMATION COMPANY  
LANDFILL, AZUSA (File No. 59-102)**

Reference is made to our letter dated October 13, 1995, which transmitted copies of three options of tentative waste discharge requirements and a monitoring and reporting program for the proposed discharge at Azusa Land Reclamation company Landfill. Option 3 of the tentative Order was revised on October 30, 1995, as follows:

Page 6, Section A.1., was modified to read: "ALRC may continue disposing MSW in the 80-acre unlined portion only, of Azusa Landfill, until December 31, 1997, as an interim Class III landfill pursuant to Regional Board Order No. 93-062." \*

Page 6, add new Section A.4.,

"ALRC shall immediately commence installation of the engineered alternatives it has proposed and which are summarized in Finding No. 17. By November 15, 1995, ALRC shall submit a schedule for the installation to be approved by the Executive Officer."

Page 13, add new Provision 1;

"Within 90 days of the adoption of this Order, ALRC shall submit a master plan, in a format acceptable to the Executive Officer, which includes a description of the long-term uses of the entire 302-acre landfill site for solid waste disposal, treatment, and recycling."

Page 13, add new Provision 2;

"Within 90 days of the adoption of this Order, ALRC shall submit a technical report acceptable to the Executive Officer on the effectiveness of the enhanced gas and liquid extraction systems. The report shall include detailed data and shall propose, if appropriate, modifications to the location and numbers of gas and/or liquid extraction wells in order to achieve the earliest practicable containment and control of gas and/or liquid leakage from the landfill."



Page 14, paragraph 12, "and Order No. 93-062, adopted September 27, 1993," deleted from end of sentence. Paragraph 12 now reads, "Resolution No. 60-22, adopted by this Regional Board on February 11, 1960, and Order No. 86-59, adopted by this Regional Board on July 28, 1988, are hereby rescinded."

Pursuant to Section 13263 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board, at a public meeting held on October 30, 1995, reviewed the Options for the tentative Orders, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. 95-151 (Option 3) and Monitoring and Reporting Program CI No. 2567 (copy attached) relative to the discharge.

Please reference all technical and monitoring reports to our Compliance File No. 2567. We would appreciate it if you would not combine other reports, such as progress and technical reports, with your monitoring reports, but would submit each report as a separate document.
