WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – CITY OF LOS ANGELES, DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER, HAYNES GENERATING STATION LOCATED AT 6801 WESTMINSTER AVENUE, LONG BEACH, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0000353, CI-2769)

Our letter dated April 19, 2004, transmitted a tentative order for revision to your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 10, 2004, reviewed the tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2004-0089 (copy attached) relative to this waste discharge. Order No. R4-2004-0089 serves as a revision to your permit Order No. 00-081 under the NPDES and expires on May 10, 2005. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

Please be aware that there were no changes made to your Monitoring and Reporting Program.
