- 1) **ADOPTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT;**
 - 2) **ADOPTED TIME SCHEDULE ORDER; AND**
 - 3) **ADOPTED CEASE AND DESIST ORDER**
- FOR LAS VIRGENES MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, TAPIA WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0056014, CI # 4760)**

Our letter dated August 23, 2010, transmitted the revised tentative waste discharge requirements for renewal of your permits to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 4, 2009, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, Time Schedule Order (TSO), and Cease and Desist Order (CDO), considered all comments received, and adopted Orders No. R4-2010-0165, R4-2010-0166, and R4-2010-0167, respectively (copies enclosed). Order No. R4-2010-0165 serves as your NPDES permit, for the Tapia WRF and expires on August 10, 2015. The TSO expires on December 31, 2014. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that a complete application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

The complete final Orders and Permit will be sent only to the Discharger. However, these documents are available on the Regional Board's website for your review. The Regional Board's web address is www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/.

You are required to implement the Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) on the effective date of the Order. The dates that the monitoring and annual reports must be received at the Regional Board Office are provided in the MRP. Submit all monitoring reports and annual reports to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge for each Order to the Regional Board, please include a reference to our Compliance File No. CI 4760 for Order No. R4-2010-0165, to assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate staff and file. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.



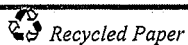
