## **RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SOUTHERN PACIFIC MILLING, EL RIO PLANT, 3555 VINEYARD AVENUE, OXNARD CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 65-022, ORDER NO. 94-088, CI 4919)**
