RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR VINTAGE PETROLEUM (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0000761, ORDER NO. 95-094, CI-5358).

Our letter dated September 24, 2001, transmitted a tentative Order which, in part, rescinds the requirements for your discharge of wastes from the subject facility to surface waters.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on October 25, 2001, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. 01-153 (copy attached) relative to this waste discharge.

Should any future activity at the subject site results in a discharge of wastewater to surface water, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Board prior to the discharge.

# RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- 1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the dischargers listed below.
- 2. These dischargers have been enrolled under a general NPDES permit or have eliminated their discharges to surface waters.
- Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
- The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.


