**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT – CITY OF LOS ANGELES – DONALD C. TILLMAN WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0056227, CI NO. 5695) AND LOS ANGELES – GLENDALE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0053953, CI NO. 5675)**


Our letter dated November 30, 2006, transmitted revised tentative orders for renewal of your permits to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on December 14, 2006, reviewed the revised tentative requirements and the Change Sheet, considered all comments received, and adopted Order R4-2006-0091 and R4-2006-0092 (copies enclosed) for your waste discharges. Both Orders serve as your NPDES permits and expires on November 10, 2011. Section 13376 of the California Water Code require that an application and Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

The complete final Orders and Permits will be sent only to the Discharger. However, these documents are available on the Regional Board's website for your review. The Regional Board's web address is [www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/).

You are required to implement the *Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP)* on the effective date of both Orders. The dates that the monitoring and annual reports must be received at the Regional Board Office are provided in the *MRP*. Submit all monitoring reports and annual reports to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge for each Order to the Regional Board, please include a reference to our *Compliance File Nos. CI 5695* and *CI 5675* for Order No. R4-2006-0091 and Order No. R4-2006-0092, respectively, to assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate staff and file. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.




