## ADOPTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES – DONALD C. TILLMAN WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0056227, CI-5695)

Dear Ms. Romero:

The Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) staff transmitted a letter containing the revised tentative WDRs and NPDES permit, and responses to comments for the City of Los Angeles' Donald C. Tillman Water Reclamation Plant on December 1, 2022.

In accordance with administrative procedures, the Los Angeles Water Board at a public hearing held on December 8, 2022, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all the factors in the case, and adopted WDRs and NPDES Order No. **R4-2022-0341**. In addition, the Los Angeles Water Board revised responses to comments D9 and D19 to reflect the language in the revised tentative requirements adopted by the Board, and response to comment D15 was modified for clarification.
