## ORDER No. R4-2005-0021

## RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

- 1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for Dischargers listed below.
- 2. These Dischargers have been enrolled under a NPDES permit or have eliminated their discharges to surface waters.
- 3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
- 4. The following Orders are hereby rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.
- 5. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits be rescinded:

Plaskolite West, Inc. (CA0060798)	R4-2002-0126 (July 11, 2002)	Waste water discharges have been diverted to the sanitary sewer system.
RMR Properties (CA0054615)	97-100 (July 21, 1997)	Waste water discharges have been diverted to the sanitary sewer system.

SUBJECT: WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (NPDES PERMIT

RESCISSION)

DISCUSSION: In accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, all

waste discharges to navigable waterways, or tributaries thereto, require National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits.

This Board adopted a NPDES permit for Plaskolite West, Inc. (R4-2002-0126) and RMR Properties (97-100). The Dischargers have been found to no longer need permits and have been field checked and verified by staff. Therefore, these permits about the received

verified by staff. Therefore, these permits should be rescinded.

A tentative order has been prepared which proposes to rescind Order

Nos. R4-2002-0126 and 97-100.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommend that the tentative Order be adopted, as proposed.
