TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER NO. R4-2014-0020 - TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES, DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER, HARBOR GENERATING STATION FUEL STORAGE NORTH SKIM TANK, WILMINGTON, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0056383, CI NO. 6004)

Our letter dated December 16, 2013, transmitted the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP), Harbor Generating Station Fuel Storage North Skim Tank facility located at 100 North Fries Avenue, Wilmington, California.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Board, at a public hearing held on February 6, 2014, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2014-0020 (copy attached) relative to the termination of Order No. R4-2008-0015.

TERMINATING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR DISCHARGE IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

- 1. This Regional Water Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharge to surface water which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Discharger listed below.
- 2. The discharge to surface water from this Facility has been eliminated.
- 3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit are no longer necessary and should be terminated.
- 4. The following Order is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
- The termination of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Water Board has notified the Discharger, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.

Order No. R4-2014-0020 Terminating Waste Discharge Requirements and NPDES Permit

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit be terminated:

City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP), Harbor Generating Station Fuel Storage North Skim Tank (CA0056383) R4-2008-0015 (April 3, 2008)

REASON FOR TERMINATION

Tank bermed area capacity is sufficient to contain the 100-year storm. There has not been a discharge from the Tank Facility since 2005. LADWP does not anticipate a discharge to surface waters in the future.

The Executive Officer of the Regional Board, is authorized and directed to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefore, or may request the same.
