

TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR JAMISON 1545 WILSHIRE, LLC — JAMISON 1545 WILSHIRE OFFICE BUILDING, LOS ANGELES, CA (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0058297, CI-6302)

Our letter dated June 17, 2011, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for the Jamison Office Building at 1545 Wilshire Boulevard.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), at a public hearing held on September 1, 2011, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2011-0148 (copy enclosed) relative to the termination of Order No. R4-2006-0064.

Should any future activities at the subject site result in discharges of wastewater to surface waters, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Water Board prior to discharge.
