APPROVAL OF MATERIAL CHANGE – THOMAS AQUINAS COLLEGE, 10000 OJAI SANTA PAULA ROAD, SANTA PAULA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 77-049, ORDER NO. R4-2008-0206, CI-6410, GLOBAL ID WDR 100000730)

Dear Mr. DeLuca,

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board), is the public agency with primary responsibility for the protection of ground and surface water quality for all beneficial uses within major portions of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, including the referenced property above.

On December 11, 2008, the Regional Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. R4-2008-0206 with Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) No. CI-6410 to authorize Thomas Aquinas College (TAC) to discharge up to 50,000 gallons per day of wastewater from an onsite wastewater treatment system at the TAC.

TAC submitted the *Report of Material Change* (Report) dated August 18, 2015 regarding modification to the number and location of plumbing fixtures on campus. TAC proposed to build a Lecture Hall building for the purposes of college-wide lectures, college theatrical performances, and musical presentations. The new Lecture Hall building will include 13 toilets, 3 urinals, 17 lavatories, 2 sinks, and 3 service sink.

As indicated in the Report, construction of the new Lecture Hall building will not result in a population change to the campus. The addition of plumbing fixtures will not result in a change to the type and volume of wastewater discharged and will not affect the onsite wastewater treatment system at the TAC. Therefore, the material change to the WDR Order No. R4-2008-0206 and MRP No. CI-6410 is approved. All requirements specified in the WDR Order No. R4-2008-0206 and MRP No. CI-6410 remain in effect.
