ADOPTED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND TIME SCHEDULE ORDER -- LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, MALIBU MESA WATER RECLAMATION PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0059099, CI NO. 6599)

Our letter dated November 9, 2012, transmitted the revised tentative waste discharge requirements for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the NPDES and the accompanying Time Schedule Order.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Water Board at a public hearing held on December 6, 2012, reviewed the revised tentative requirements and the Time Schedule Order, considered all the factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2012-0181 and Order No. R4-2012-0182, respectively. Order No. R4-2012-0181 serves as your NPDES permit and expires on November 10, 2017. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application and Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date. A copy of the adopted orders and attachments are enclosed.

The complete adopted Orders and attachments will be sent only to the Discharger. However, these documents are available on the Regional Water Board's website for your review. The Regional Water Board's web address is www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/.
