**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – Covina Irrigating Company, William B. Temple – Water Treatment Plant #1 (NPDES No. CA0060577, CI-6849)**

Our letter dated September 7, 2010, transmitted the tentative waste discharge requirements for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program. On October 12, 2010, we further transmitted you minor revisions to the tentative fact sheet of the tentative permit.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on November 4, 2010, reviewed the tentative requirements, considered all comments received, and adopted Order R4-2010-0197 (copy enclosed). This Order serves as your NPDES permit and expires on October 10, 2015. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application and Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

You are required to implement the Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) on the effective date (December 4, 2010) of the permit. The dates that the monitoring reports must be received at the Regional Board Office are provided in the MRP. Submit all monitoring reports to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge under Order No. R4-2010-0197 to the Regional Board, please include a reference to our Compliance File No. **CI 6849** to ensure that the reports are directed to the appropriate staff and file. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.



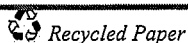
