**RESCISSION OF NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – JAYEAST PARTNERSHIP, CENTRAL PLAZA, CERRITOS, CALIFORNIA (CA0061336; CI-6914)**

Reference is made to your Waste Discharge Requirements adopted by this Regional Board for the discharge of wastes at your facility to surface water.

This Regional Board, at a public hearing on June 29, 1998, adopted a general NPDES permit for similar discharge (NPDES No. CAG994003; Order No. 98-055). General permits offer several advantages when compared to individual permits including uniform coverage of similar discharge, simplified discharge requirements, and flexible compliance oversight.

Based on our review of your facility's information, we have determined that regulation of your facility under the General Permit is appropriate. We will send the General Permit (NPDES No. CAG994003). Therefore, your individual NPDES permit No. CA0061336 adopted on June 12, 1995, will be rescinded at the Board Meeting to be held on September 16, 1999.

In accordance with administrative procedures, this Board at a public hearing to be held on **September 16, 1999**, at 9:00 a.m., at Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, 700 N. Alameda (next door to Union Station), Main Board Room, Los Angeles, California, will consider the enclosed tentative Order which, in part, rescinds the requirements for this discharge.

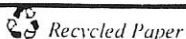

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
AND  
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS  
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for dischargers listed below.
2. These dischargers has been enrolled under a general NPDES permits.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
4. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements be rescinded:
