On August 8, 1991, you filed with this Regional Board a complete Report of Waste Discharge to use residential subsurface sewage disposal systems (septic tanks) on Santiago Road, 350 feet north of Sierra Highway in the Acton area, for four units on five acres. Each unit will rely on septic tanks for household sewage disposal.

The Executive Officer has reviewed the information provided and has determined that the proposed discharge meets the conditions specified in Order No. 91-94, "General Waste Discharge Requirements for Residential Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems", adopted by this Board on July 22, 1991.

Enclosed are Waste Discharge Requirements, comprising:

- 1. General Waste Discharge Requirements
- 2. Monitoring and Reporting Program

Please note that the Monitoring and Reporting Program requires that a report be submitted to this Board within 60 days prior to the commencement of discharge into residential subsurface sewage disposal systems. The report shall reference CI File number 7803.
