**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE
ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – WALT DISNEY CONCERT HALL PARKING
GARAGE, 111 SOUTH GRAND AVENUE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994001, CI-7227)**

We have reviewed your January 15, 2007 letter which requested termination of coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained sewer discharge permit from the City of Los Angeles and have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject facility to Los Angeles River.


The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-045, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on May 12, 1997, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On March 22, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Los Angeles River. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. 97-045, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994001, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
