
TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—JPMC, 13949 VENTURA BOULEVARD, SHERMAN OAKS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-7407)

In our letter dated January 9, 2004, we determined that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as the NPDES permit.

In a letter dated September 10, 2009, you requested termination of the subject permit because you have stopped your discharge. On November 4, 2009, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2003-0111 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters. 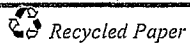
