TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—WEST BASIN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, WEST BASIN WATER RECYCLING FACILITY, 1935 HUGHES WAY, EL SEGUNDO, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-7492)

In our letter dated May 12, 1997, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-047, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

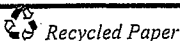
In an email dated September 27, 2007, you requested Regional Board to terminate your coverage under the General NPDES permit because the recycling water used for project does not meet the requirements for renewal under the General NPDES permit CAG674001, Order No. R4-2004-0109. On September 27, 2007, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order 97-047 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
