**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – WORLD OIL MARKETING COMPANY, STATION NO. 61, 10970 E. SOUTH STREET, CERRITOS (NPDES CAG834001, CI-7494)**

In our letter dated September 16, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On October 12, 2005, you informed Regional Board staff that the treatment system from the above facility has not been operated since March 2003. Therefore, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On December 9, 2005, our staff inspected the facility, and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain from the subject site.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0125 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any questions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576-6794.
