TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – SPYGLASS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, 11762 RANCHO VERDE DRIVE, WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-7555)

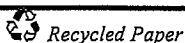
In our letter dated March 9, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your August 17, 2006, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained permit from Los Angeles County Sanitation District to discharge groundwater to sanitary sewer system. Subsequently, you have connected the discharge line from the facility to the sanitary sewer.

On May 24, 2007, Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site to the San Gabriel River. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.



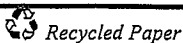
