
TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—SUBURBAN WATER SYSTEMS, PLANT 139, WELL NOS. 2, 4, 5, AND 6, 187 N. WILLOW AVENUE, WEST COVINA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES CAG994005, CI—7607)

In our letter dated November 18, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

Suburban Water Systems (Suburban) operates potable water supply wells located in the vicinity of their West Covina service area. In order to manage the NPDES permit compliance more effectively, permits for wells that discharge into the same waterbody with identical water quality objectives can be combined into one permit. Consequently, Suburban has requested to consolidate its enrollment under the general NPDES permit to cover potable water supply wells grouped according to receiving waterbodies and/or stream reaches. On December 5, 2007, the Regional Board consolidated the enrollment of Plant 139, Well Nos. 2, 4, 5, 6, and other wells in the same vicinity under one permit (CAG994005, Order No. R4-2003-0108, CI-7368). Therefore, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108, CI-7607 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

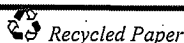

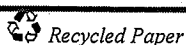
