

REVISION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – PLAYA CAPITAL COMPANY, LLC, PLAYA VISTA, 6775 CENTINELA AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-7648)

We have completed our review of your April 13, 2006, letter requesting to relocate outfall 01 discharge location from the Riparian Corridor east of Lincoln Boulevard to the Riparian Corridor west of Lincoln Boulevard. Discharge of groundwater generated from the above-referenced facility is currently regulated under NPDES General Permit No. CAG994004 (Order No. R4-2003-0111), General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003. On December 16, 2003, Playa Capital Company was enrolled under the general permit for discharge of treated groundwater associated with construction dewatering activities at the facility.

Based on the information provided, we have no objections to you relocating the discharge location as proposed. Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your NPDES permit, consisting of Order No. R4-2003-0111 and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-7648. The discharge limitations in Parts E.1.a. and E.1.c. of Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the specific constituents listed on the Table with the enclosed Fact Sheet are applicable to your discharge. The groundwater discharge flows to Ballona Creek; therefore, the discharge limits in Attachment B of Order No. R4-2003-0111 are not applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, <u>ATTN: Information Technology Unit.</u> When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-7648 and NPDES No. CAG994004", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

In order to avoid future annual fees, please submit written notification when the project has been completed and the permit is no longer needed.
