TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CHEVRON MANAGEMENT ENVIRONMENTAL COMPANY (CHEVRON), FORMER LA MIRADA PLANT #0510, 14445 ALONDRA BOULEVARD, LA MIRADA CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CA0063975, CI NO. 7688)

Dear Mr. Jauregui:

Our letter dated March 16, 2010, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for Chevron Management Environmental Company (Chevron), former La Mirada Plant #0510.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Board, at a public hearing held on May 6, 2010, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2010-0070 (copy attached) relative to the termination of Order No. R4-2005-0056.

Should any future activities at the subject site result in discharges of wastewater to surface waters, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Water Board prior to discharge.

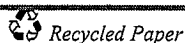

TERMINATING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
AND
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board), finds:

1. This Regional Water Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also served as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for the Discharger listed below.
2. This Discharger has eliminated its discharges to surface waters.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit are no longer necessary and should be terminated.
4. The following Order is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The termination of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Water Board has notified the Discharger, interested agencies, and persons of its intent to consider termination of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.

The Regional Water Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to this matter.


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit be terminated:
