TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—STRATEGIC WELL TESTING AND GROUNDWATER MONITORING PROGRAM, MAIN SAN GABRIEL BASIN, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI-7718)

In our letter dated May 20, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0107, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Treated Groundwater from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

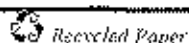
In an email dated July 11, 2007, from your consultant Mr. Kevin Smead, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project has been completed. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2002-0107 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters. 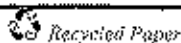
