PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Eric Realty, Inc. discharges treated groundwater from cleanup of volatile organic compounds impacted groundwater at 16055 Heron Avenue in La Mirada. Eric Realty, Inc. extracts and treats the impacted groundwater using activated carbon.

VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE

Approximately 4,500 gallons per day of treated groundwater is discharged to the storm drain at Latitude 33° 53' 00", Longitude 118° 2' 00". Discharge from the storm drain flows into Coyote Creek, a water of the United States. See Figure 1 for site location map and Figure 2 for schematic of treatment flow diagram.

FREQUENCY OF DISCHARGE

Discharge from the facility is continuous.

REUSE OF WATER

Due to the limited volume of the wastewater, there are no feasible reuse alternatives. Therefore, the wastewater will be discharged to the storm drain.
