

ORDER NO. R4-2005-0039

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

- This Regional Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the Discharger listed below.
- 2. Board staff has verified, by inspection, that the discharge for the Tierra Rejada Golf Club owned by Crumpler & Kruger Golf Development, LLC meets the conditions specified under General Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Commercial and Multifamily Residential Subsurface Sewage Disposal Systems (Order No. 01-131), and is enrolled under the General Waste Discharge Requirements.
- 3. The Board finds that Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 98-010 is no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
- 4. The Board has transmitted copies of this tentative Order to the Discharger and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind requirements at a public meeting to be held on June 2, 2005.
- 5. At that public meeting, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following requirements be rescinded:
