TRANSMITTAL OF THE NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT (NPDES) (ORDER NO. R4-2010-0018) FOR VOPAK TERMINAL LONG BEACH, INCORPORATED, VOPAK TERMINAL LONG BEACH, LONG BEACH - NPDES NO. CA0064165, CI NO. 7873

Our letter dated January 19, 2010, transmitted the revised tentative Order for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on February 4, 2010, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted the proposed NPDES permit.

The adopted Order (Order R4-2010-0018) serves as an NPDES permit, and expires on January 10, 2015. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application/Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date (March 6, 2010) of this Order. Your first monitoring report for the period of January 1, 2010, through March 31, 2010, is due by May 1, 2010. Monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to Compliance File CI-7873 and NPDES No. CA0064165, which will assure that the reports, are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports, such as progress reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
