TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CALLEGUAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, GRIMES CANYON WELL FIELD NO. 1, 5700 GRIMES CANYON ROAD, MOORPARK, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-7985)

Dear Ms. Mulligan:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have reviewed an email from Ms. Amy Maday of your office dated November 8, 2012, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The email indicated that you have stopped discharging from the above-referenced facility to surface water and that the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed.

On November 14, 2012, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility to surface water. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the facility, coverage under Board Order R4-2003-0108, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994005 for the facility is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
