**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—UNITED STORM WATER, INC., CALTRANS STORM DRAIN CLEANING PROJECT, 105 GLEN ANDERSON FREEWAY INTERSECTING 110 HARBOR FREEWAY, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8024)**

Dear Mr. Perry:

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008.


We have reviewed your May 10, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed your project at the above-referenced site and that wastewater discharge from the subject facility to the Los Angeles River has been ceased.

On October 13, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of wastewater from the facility to the Los Angeles River. Since there is no discharge of wastewater from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the facility is hereby terminated.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
