

TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—HONEYWELL INTERNATIONAL INC.—FORMER HONEYWELL SEPULVEDA FACILITY, 9851 SEPULVEDA BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG914001, CI-8032)

In our letter dated February 3, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0107, Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater From Investigation and/or Cleanup of Volatile Organic Compounds Contaminated-sites to Surface Waters in the Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on May 23, 2002, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your June 1, 2007, letter which requested termination of coverage under the General Permit. It is our understanding that you have not discharged groundwater from the subject facility since January 2006.

On July 25, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject project, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0107, General NPDES Permit No. CAG914001 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
