TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—WARNER BROTHERS ENTERTAINMENT INC., WARNER BROTHERS STUDIO FACILITIES, 4000 WARNER BOULEVARD, BURBANK, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI-8060)

In our letter dated February 28, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Nonprocess Wastewaters Not Requiring Treatment Systems to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your May 11, 2010, email requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The email indicated that you have ceased discharge from Stage 15, Stage 16, and the lagoon at your facility.

On May 13, 2010, Board staff inspected the above-mentioned facility and verified that there is no discharge of wastewater from the facility to surface waters. Since there is no discharge from the facility, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2004-0058, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994003, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

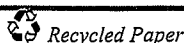
