ATTACHMENT F

Manure Management Plan (MMP)

- 1. Ensure adequate of storage of manure, litter, and process wastewater, including the procedures to ensure proper operation and maintenance of the storage facilities;
- 2. Ensure proper management of mortalities (i.e., dead animals) to ensure that they are not disposed of in a liquid manure, storm water, or process wastewater storage or treatment system that is not specifically designed to treat animal mortalities.
- 3. Ensure that clean water is diverted, as appropriate, from the production area;
- 4. Prevent direct contact of confined animals with waters of, or waters tributary to, the United States;
- 5, Ensure that chemicals and other contaminants handled on-site are not disposed of in any manure, litter, process wastewater, or storm water storage or treatment system unless specifically designed to treat such chemicals and other contaminants;
- 6. Identify appropriate site-specific conservation practices to be implemented, including as appropriate, buffers or equivalent practices to control runoff of pollutants to waters of the United States; and
- 7. Identify site-specific records that will be maintained to document the implementation and management of the minimum elements described in items (i) through (viii).

The Discharger is required to submit a statement with each annual self-monitoring report confirming that Fairplex has not land-applied any manure or wastewater during that year. However, if the Discharger wishes to land-apply manure or process wastewater, the Discharger shall notify the Regional Board and develop a NMP that incorporates all the elements specified in Attachment A in accordance with 40 CFR section 122.42(e)(1).
