WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS - LOS ANGELES COUNTY FAIR, HOTEL, AND EXPOSITION COMPLEX (FAIRPLEX), POMONA, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0064254 NO. 8101)

Our letters dated May 25, 2006, August 19, 2005, and April 12, 2006, respectively transmitted tentative order and revised tentative orders for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on July 13, 2006, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2006-0061 (copy attached) relative to this waste discharge. Order No. R4-2006-0061 serves as your permit under the NPDES and expires on June 10, 2011. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

You are required to implement the *Monitoring and Reporting Program* (MRP) on the effective date of Order No. R4-2006-0061. Your first monitoring report for the July – September reporting period is due by November 1, 2006. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge under Order No. R4-2006-0061 to the Regional Board, please include a reference to *Compliance File No. CI 8101 and NPDES No. CA0064254*, which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Please submit each type of report as a separate document.
