TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR NOVA DEVELOPMENT COMPANY TRACT 52882 AT CARSON MESA ROAD, ACTON, CALIFORNIA 93550 (ORDER NO. 91-94, FILE NO. 99-158, CI-8113)


On December 28, 1999, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the Facility ID 4A196500019 at Tract 52882 site is regulated under Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order No. 91-94 to discharge treated wastewater from a private subsurface sewage disposal systems to groundwater basins in Acton, Ventura County.

In a letter dated December 6, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that the Nova Development Company requested termination of the WDR coverage for Tract 52882.

Because the project has been formally abandoned by the Los Angeles County Regional Planning and the residential tract was never developed as planned, WDR coverage is no longer needed. The coverage under Board Order No. 91-94 for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
