COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS - DEWATERING CONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN THE VENTURA RIVER AT THE SANTA ANA BRIDGE CROSSING, LOCATED IN OAK VIEW, VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994001, CI-8193)

We have completed our review of your application for a permit to discharge wastewater to surface water under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). We understand that you have contracted with Union Engineering to complete this project. Based on the information provided, we have determined that the proposed discharge of groundwater meets the conditions to be regulated under Order No. 97-045; "General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements For Groundwater Discharges From Construction And Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties", adopted by this Board on May 12, 1997.

Enclosed are General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements consisting of Order No. 97-045, and Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8193. You are to implement the "Monitoring and Reporting Program" upon receipt of this Order. Monitoring reports should be sent to this Regional Board, <u>ATTN:</u> <u>Information Technology Unit</u>.
