TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—GOLDEN STATE WATER COMPANY-SAN GABRIEL WATER TREATMENT PLANT, 2630 SAN GABRIEL BOULEVARD, ROSEMEAD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI-8252

In our letter dated July 29, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0058, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Nonprocess Wastewater to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on April 1, 2004, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your April 27, 2009, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have ceased discharging activated carbon vessels flush water since 2006.

On May18, 2009, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of vessel flush water from the project site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0058, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994003, for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any carbon vessel flush water to surface water become necessary at the site, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
