TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER, BURBANK TRUNK LINE PROJECT, MAGNOLIA & BURBANK BOULEVARD, BURBANK, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-8262)

In our letter dated November 9, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0109, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

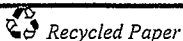
In a letter dated September 5, 2007, you requested this Regional Board to terminate your coverage under the General NPDES permit because the hydrostatic test project at the above-referenced site has been completed. On September 27, 2007, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2002-0125 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
