REVISED COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DISTRICT 7), PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD AND ROUTE 1, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8296)

Discharge of treated groundwater from the construction of a crossover bridge located at Pleasant Valley Road and Route 1 in the City of Oxnard is currently regulated under NPDES General Permit No. CAG994004 (Order No. R4-2003-0111) adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003. By a letter dated April 6, 2004, the State of California Department of Transportation (District 7) requested that its coverage under General NPDES Permit Order No. R4-2003-0111 be revised to include discharge from the construction of a new storm drain at Etting Road.

Based on the information submitted, the State of California Department of Transportation - District 7 is hereby authorized to include the additional discharge activity located at Etting Road in Oxnard, California under the General NPDES permit. Figure 1 shows the new discharge location.

You are required to implement the attached revised "Monitoring and Reporting Program" (CI-8296) on the effective date of this permit. Monitoring reports shall be submitted monthly and are to be received by the Regional Board by the first day of the second month following sampling. If there is no discharge, the report shall so state. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8296 and NPDES No. CAG994004", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

In order to avoid future annual fees, please submit written notification when the project has been completed and the permit is no longer needed.
