



TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT — STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DISTRICT 7) – PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD AND ROUTE 1 PROJECT, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8296)

In our letter dated April 14, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your January 29, 2007, letter which requested termination of coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject project site to storm drain since June 2004.

On February 2, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
