PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Boy Scouts of America proposes to discharge groundwater generated during the construction and well development of a potable water well located at Camp Josepho Boy Scout Camp, 300 Rustic Canyon Road, Pacific Palisades. Well development and aquifer pumping test will be performed after completion of the well. A desilting tank will be installed to clarify the water before discharge.

VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE:

Up to 0.060 million gallons per day of groundwater will be discharged during well construction, well development, and aquifer pumping test. Well development and aquifer tests will be completed within one month after the well construction. The analytical results of groundwater samples from adjacent well indicate that the groundwater discharge will meet effluent limits without treatment. The groundwater will be discharged to Rustic Canyon Creek (Latitude: 34° 04' 59", Longitude: 118° 31' 18"), a Miscellaneous Streams and Coastal Features in Los Angeles County, and a water of the United States. The site plan location is shown in Figure 1.

FREQUENCY OF DISCHARGE:

The discharge will be intermittent.

REUSE OF WATER:

Most of the pumped groundwater will be used for irrigation within the vicinity of the well. Only a small portion of groundwater will be discharged into the dry Rustic Canyon Creek bed.
