TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT - COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, HOLLYHILLS DRAIN UNIT 7 PROJECT, BEVERLY HILLS AND WEST LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994002, CI-8354)

In our letter dated January 9, 2002, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-043, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Treated Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your letter dated March 2, 2004, requesting termination of coverage under General NPDES Permit No. CAG994002 (Order No. 97-043) for the subject project. The letter indicated that there was no discharge of groundwater during the construction project to the storm drain system.

On March 12, 2004, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. 97-043, general NPDES Permit No. CAG994002, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
