TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – TOLAND ROAD LANDFILL, 3500 TOLAND ROAD, SANTA PAULA, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. 01-031, SERIES NO. 008, CI-8446, GLOBAL ID. WDR100000001)

Dear Mr. Jones,

On August 6, 2002, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. 01-031, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated May 14, 2014, Ventura Regional Sanitation District (VRSD) requested termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. 01-031 because operational shutdown of the onsite wastewater treatment system at Toland Road Landfill facility on April 26, 2013. VRSD has hauled the wastewater generated from the facility to the Santa Clara Waste Water for offsite disposal.

Since the discharge of wastewater has been ceased at the facility, VRSD no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. 01-031 for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement actions that may be taken under the term of the permit.
