TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR WATT ENTERPRISES, LTD, TRACT# 46205, 4468 ESCONDIDO CANYON ROAD, ACTON, CALIFORNIA, (ORDER NO. 91-94, FILE NO. 02- 052, CI NO. 8448)

Dear Ms. Watt:


In our letter dated September 16, 2002, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 91-94, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated February 16, 2011, you notified the Regional Board that you requested termination of the WDR because the lots were reverted to open land in 2005 and the tract will not be developed.

Because the proposed development of Tract# 46205 did not occur as stated in your correspondence dated February 16, 2011, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Board Order No. 91-94, for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
