## PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Painted Turtle Gang Camp Foundation proposes to build the Painted Turtle Camp, a residential camp for ill children. During grading of the site and placement of utility pipes, the site may need to be dewatered.

## **VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE**

Up to 500 gallons per day of groundwater will be discharged into a sediment trap or sediment basin and then into the small ponds on the property located at Latitude: 34° 39' 33"N, Longitude: 118° 23' 24"W. The ponds drain to Elizabeth Lake, a water of the United States. The facility location is shown on the attached Figure 1.

#### FREQUENCY OF DISCHARGE

Discharge will occur for a period of approximately 60 days.

# **REUSE OF WATER**

Reuse has been considered but due to the small amount of water being generated, there is no feasible reuse option for the groundwater at the site.
