

TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AT EXXONMOBIL OIL CORPORATION SERVICE STATION #18-H7A, 855 WENDY DRIVE, NEWBURY PARK, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2002-0030, SERIES NO. 006, CI-8470)

Dear Mr. Hanely:

In our letter dated October 2, 2002, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0030, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the fax dated October 11, 2011, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030 because the groundwater extraction and treatment system (GWET) has been shut down and there is no re-injection of treated groundwater at the subject site.

Since you have no plan to operate GEWT in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
