TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR EL DORADO CLEANERS – EL DORADO CLEANERS, 8171 WARDLOW ROAD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA. (SLIC NO. 822, SITE ID 204BF00, FILE NO. 01-116, ORDER NO. R4-2005-0030, SERIES 034, CI-8496)

Dear Mr. Reynolds:

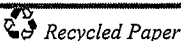
In our letter dated November 22, 2002, we informed you that your proposed discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0030 (Series No. 002), which also serves as your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR). General WDR Order No. R4-2005-0030 (Series No. 034) was adopted on May 5, 2005 to supersede General WDR Order No. R4-2002-0030. The Monitoring and Reporting Program for your WDR was subsequently revised on December 16, 2005 and April 30, 2007, for proposed change of oxidant and sampling frequency, respectively. The relevant information of your WDR is listed as follows:


