TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – THE GARDENS AT DARLINGTON, 11863 DARLINGTON AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994001, CI-8502)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-045, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In a letter dated May 27, 2004, your agent, Pacific Northstar Property Group, LLC, requested termination of the subject permit because there is no longer a groundwater discharge to surface waters from the subject site. An inspection conducted by staff from this office on June 17, 2004, confirmed that the dewatering activities from the construction project at the subject site have been completed.

Since discharge of groundwater to surface waters has been eliminated, an NPDES permit is not necessary and coverage under Board Order No. 97-045 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
