ORDER NO. R4-2004-0094

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region finds:

1. This Regional Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the dischargers listed below.
2. These dischargers have terminated their waste discharges or have not had any discharge from their facilities since issuance of the waste discharge requirements.
3. Board staff has verified that these facilities have discontinued discharging waste or there is no waste discharged.
4. The Board finds that these requirements are no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
5. The Board has transmitted copies of this tentative Order to the dischargers and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind requirements at a public meeting to be held on June 10, 2004.
6. At that public meeting, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following Orders be rescinded, except as may be necessary for enforcement:
