TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, MANDALAY GENERATING STATION ADVANCED ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM, 393 NORTH HARBOR BOULEVARD, OXNARD, CALIFORNIA 93035 (FILE NO. 02-158, ORDER NO. 2014-0153-DWQ, SERIES NO. 038, CI-8561, GLOBAL ID. WDR 100001607)

Dear Mr. Di Ciolli,

On August 28, 2018, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under State Water Resource Control Board (State Board) Order No. 2014-0153-DWQ, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated October 3, 2018, you requested termination of WDR coverage under State Board Order No. 2014-0153-DWQ because Mandalay Generating Station has no further on-site septage treatment and has not discharged to the mound leach field since August 30, 2018. Future septage management will consist of pumping and hauling the septage to a licensed waste water treatment facility. The coverage under State Board Order No. 2014-0153-DWQ for the subject site is no longer needed and hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes to address noncompliance, if any, during the term of permit coverage.
